

# Important Safety Instructions

**(Anyone operating the SpaceSaver Dunk Tank must read prior.)**

- ◆ **Never leave a filled Dunk Tank unattended by an adult. When tank is unattended, always drain water.**
- ◆ **Keep Dunk Tank away from electricity.**
- ◆ **Keep all non-swimmers and anyone less than 4' tall out of tank.**
- ◆ **To keep from slipping, always wear tennis shoes.**
- ◆ **When setting up or tearing down, use caution to avoid being pinch between panels.**
- ◆ **Keep water level filled to at least 8" from top of tank.**

# Set-Up Instructions

1. **Select level area, and remove any stones, sticks or sharp debris. (Figure 2)**
2. **Unfold side panels (use netting posts as handles), to create a hexagon. (Figures 3 & 4)**

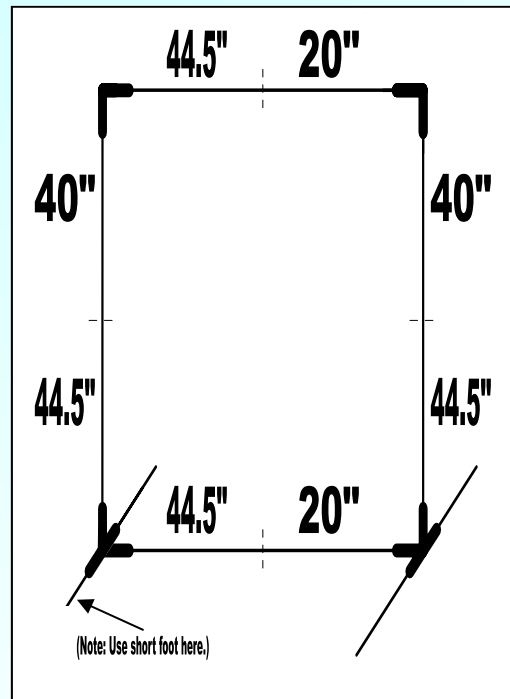

3. Using the pipes and fittings, assemble the back-stop frame as per figure 5. (Figures 5&6)

4. Put liner in place and secure with ball bungees. (Figure 7)

5. Using the ball bungees attach the canvas to the wing and place the arm into the pivot point. (Figures 8 & 9)

6. Place uprights onto posts, and secure netting. (Figure 10)

7. Wrap the tank with graphics banner. (Figure 11)

8. Slide out side platform and secure with latch.

9. Hang ladder from bracket.
